Method of work: We aim to work together on a regular basis, keeping up regular penpal contact, and sending each other work completed in each of our schools.

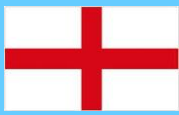
Expected results: For the students to see working practice of learning a language, by being able to communicate with others in the language they are learning. To create a good link with another school, for continuing to share culture and language in the future.

The students from Bristol greet their penpals for the third time, and talk about the summer holidays.

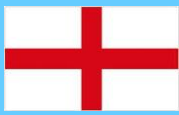
They talk about how in their school they are studying about food in Spanish. Ask them about their favourite food.

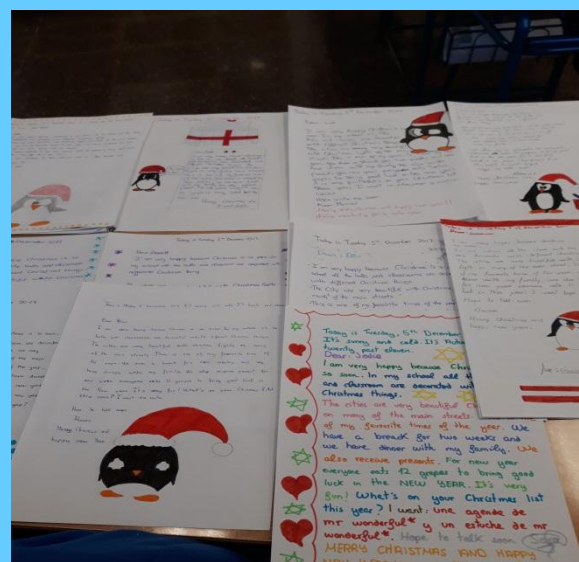
Here is a poster with photos of all the children from 6C as well as the students from the 6th Grade at Wick Primary in Bristol.

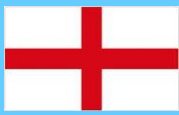

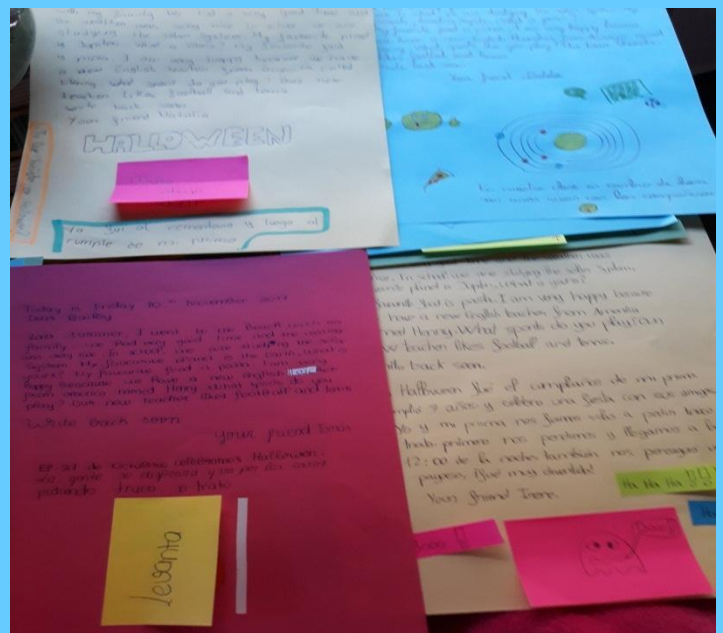
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Peregrines 5th C

They talk about the subjects they are learning in school, which included the Solar System at the time. The students gave their favourite planet, and asked for their pen pals.



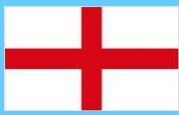
