First of all, we can see some activities that were done for Halloween in Ramon's physical education class!


They cut out and made spiders and were able to decorate them whichever way they liked! Some went for the classic black spider whereas others decided to colour theirs in differently like in green and orange!


# <u>eTwinning – Sharing our languages and culture</u> <u>Wick CE Primary School, Bristol, United Kingdom</u>


