He was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 2009 for his efforts of diplomacy and cooperation during his presidency.

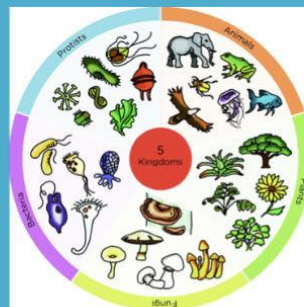


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Presentation on the 5 Kingdoms of Living Things in 4th Grade
